The music in St. Mark's Venice owed much to the East. Venice was on the trade route from the East and the wealth of the city came from this source. Services in St. Mark's were held at the behest of the civil authorities as St. Mark's was the chapel of the Doges, the rulers of Venice. It was the scene of celebrations of feast days and ceremonial events as well as saints days and religious festivals.

There is a wealth of music, both vocal and instrumental which was composed for the celebrations and we will be playing music by Andrea Gabrieli, Giovanni Gabrieli, Croce, Bassano and others.

Among the music to be studied will be **Canzon Prima** by Giovanni Gabrieli, **Dic nobis Maria** by Bassano, and **Hodie Completi Sunt** by Croce.

Getting to West Oxford Community Centre

The Centre is on the West side of Oxford, on the Botley Road opposite St Frideswide's Church.



Buses

The following buses from the City Centre or Botley pass the front door: ask for Osney Island / St Frideswide's Church

4 4A 4B 4C	Rose Hill – Botley Road – Botley	Every 10 mins daytime Mon – Sat daytimes
S1	George St – Botley Road – Witney	Frequent
U1	Harcourt Hill – Botley Road – Headington Hill – Wheatley. Get off at Osney Island	About every 30 mins in term time

Car

The centre itself does have a small car park and there is an overflow car park which we can use. In addition up to two parking spaces are available at the church opposite. There is almost no street parking (except for cars with West Oxford Residents parking permits or Visitor permits). Alternatively, there is the Seacourt Park and Ride http://www.parkandride.net/oxford/html/oxford_parkandride.html close by. From the park and ride take the 400 bus to the City Centre and get off at the first stop.

Train

The centre is 10 minutes' walk from the station. Follow the main Botley Road west out of town. Cross the river and we are right opposite the church.
